1. Signed Enrollment Form (enclosed)
2. Original birth certificate
3. Proof of residency – An original of ONE of the following:
  - ♦ Current ComEd bill
  - ♦ Current Nicor bill
  - ♦ Current Rental Lease Agreement (with name of the parent/legal guardian on the lease)
  - ♦ Property Tax bill (with name of the parent/legal guardian on the bill)

*If a parent/guardian is not listed on the proof of residency provided, an appointment to review residency is necessary before the student can begin school. Please call Ms. Vanek at 847-755-4627 to arrange an appointment.*

**This year, incoming 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will not participate in placement testing.** Students will be placed into levels of English, Math, Science courses based on course participation in junior high school, junior high teacher recommendation, and performance on academic assessments (as needed). Students will be able to select electives based on the same criteria. Participation in the Incoming Freshman Academy Math and Reading Summer School Program will be dependent on course placement.
