



School IDs



- IDs must be displayed when you enter the building

 provide you with access
 to Off Campus
- Replacement IDs cost \$3





School IDs



- All Students will be required to scan their ID upon entering the building.
- You should have your ID out and prepared to scan when you enter the building
- Temporary IDs will be required for students who do not have their ID.

Tardies and Truancies



If you are not through the threshold of the classroom door when the bell rings, you are considered tardy.

- Your teacher may have a different definition of tardy, such as being in your seat when the bell rings.
- If you accumulate too many tardies, you will be called to see the Dean and may possibly receive consequences.

If you are more than five minutes late to class without a pass or your absence is unexcused, you are considered truant.

- Truancy means you are technically absent to class
- You may lose credit for the days activities
- A call home will be made

Tardies and absences could result in consequences such as:

- Loss of privileges
- A personalized travel plan in the building
- Lunch Detention
- Loss of off campus privileges (upperclassmen)
- Conference with guardian and administrator



Digital Devices & Social Media




- Think before you post -- do not post without permission

SAT Prep Classes 22–23




- Students will be selected to take SAT Prep classes based on their PSAT 10 Scores last year


