Locker Contents and Personal Possessions

Summer School 2020

Parents can use the <u>Infinite Campus Parent Portal</u> to register your son or daughter for a previously requested summer school course. Due to public health restrictions, we are unable to provide our popular summer athletic and activity camps this summer.

We will conduct all 2020 summer school academic courses via remote learning. All schools will follow the same daily schedule with classes starting at 8:00 a.m. and ending at 11:30 a.m. Monday through Thursday each week. Semester one will be held from June 2 through June 23 and semester two will take place from June 24 through July 15.

Your school's student services department will assist you with any questions about summer school.

Registration for the 2020-2021 School Year

The first day of classes for the 2020-2021 school year will be Thursday, August 13. All students must register for the upcoming school year before they can attend classes in the fall. In June, you will receive detailed information about how to register and how to use the *MySchoolBucks* app.

D211 Meal Bags

We received great news that our Food and Nutrition Services Department will be able to continue our standing operation of distributing meal bags each Thursday through the end of summer school.

The next date that meal bags will be available is Thursday, May 21. Drive-thru, nocontact pick-up is available for families at Palatine High School (1111 N. Rohlwing Road in Palatine) and the G.A. McElroy Administration Center (1750 S. Roselle Road in Palatine) from 9:00-11:00 a.m., and at Hoffman Estates High School (1100 W. Higgins Road in Hoffman Estates) from 9:00 a.m. - noon.
