- Title I Study Jams

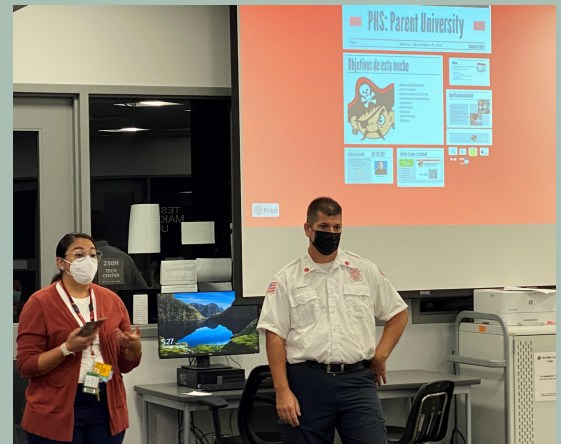
