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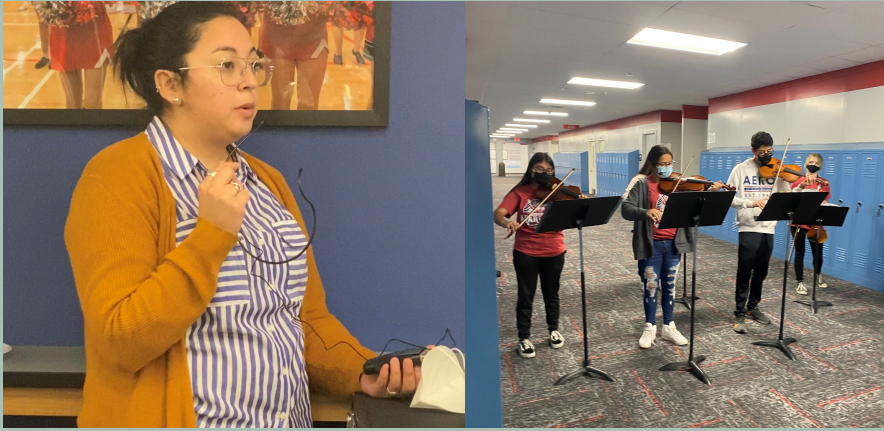


Title I Staff: Attendance Interventionist

The goal of this position is to help students get to class every day and get to class on time. The Attendance Interventionist works directly with the Title I Social Worker in identifying students that need extra assistance in managing their school schedules. The Attendance Interventionist also works closely with the Dean of Students and Assistant Principals, staying in contact with them about chronic attendance problems.

Title I Staff: Teacher Assistants

Title I teacher assistants (T.A.'s) in the Math and English Department are utilized in the tutoring centers and classrooms. Teacher assistants provide a supportive environment in which students may complete homework, study for tests, and receive literacy support across the curriculum. Classroom teacher assistants support students in all targeted courses. T.A.'s allow for differentiated instruction by providing small group and individual reinforcement. They also emphasize reading and math comprehension strategies, writing skills, and organizational methods to ensure the overall academic success of students.

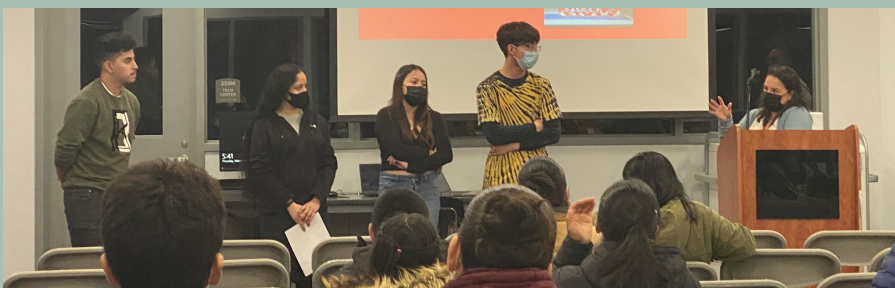

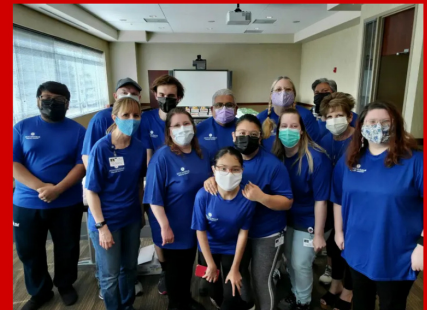
