Freedom of Information Act Requests

The Board of Education received and reviewed a report on Freedom of Information Act requests and responses.

Diesel Emission Reduction Act School Bus Rebate Program Award Recipient

The Board of Education received and reviewed information on Township High School District 211 being a recipient of funding totaling \$200,000 toward the purchase of alternative-fuel school buses through the Environmental Protection Agency’s 2018 Diesel Emission Reduction Act School Rebate Program.

Superintendent Cates made the following comments:

“We have been replacing some of our diesel buses with propane buses. I just wanted to highlight that this is a grant whereby we received \$200,000 this year. We presently have 15 propane buses and after the summer, we will have 30. The propane buses are more economical. We calculate that they cost \$1,500 less per year to operate and with this grant, it is about \$2,500 less a year. They have an annual lower fuel cost; they have reduced maintenance; they are certainly better on the environment; and they have been proven to be more reliable in the winter. I want to again acknowledge the transportation department and the work that has been done there to improve the District’s efficiency and this has certainly been one of those avenues. We are very pleased to receive this grant this year.”
