Hoffman Estates High School 2019-2020 SCHOOL REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Classes begin on Monday, August 12, 2019

All students must be ENROLLED and REGISTERED before the first day of school attendance.

Enrollment, a one-time process, requires valid proof of residency and up-to-date health records.

Registration, an annual process, requires updating of household information and payment of fees.

STEP-BY-STEP ONLINE REGISTRATION PROCESS

Between **July 1 – August 4, 2019,** school registration can be accomplished online using your **Infinite Campus Parent** account. Log on, select **More** on the left-hand side, and complete these four steps:

- 1. Review and update *Address Information*. If you have a new home address, you <u>must</u> contact the student services office at Hoffman Estates High School to update your child's residency.
- 2. Review and update *Family Information*.
- 3. For each child, review and update **Demographics**. If you have more than one child enrolled at Hoffman Estates High School, you will need to select each child one at a time.
- 4. Select the *Registration* link on the right side of the *More* screen. The system will guide you through the registration process, including payment of fees using a credit or debit card (MasterCard, Visa, American Express, or Discover).

What if I qualify for the National School Lunch and Breakfast Program?

Qualifications and other details regarding the National School Lunch and Breakfast Program will be sent to all families in late July. Families eligible for this Federal program are <u>not</u> able to register online and <u>must come to Hoffman Estates High School during in-person registration</u> on one of the designated dates in order to complete the registration process.



Parents will receive notice of their child's school bus route and pick-up time via mail in late July.

Call the Transportation Department at 847-755-6798 if you live <u>less than</u> 1.5 miles from school and want to purchase optional bus transportation services.

You must attend In-Person Registration if you:

- Qualify for the National School Lunch and Breakfast Program
- Want to pay fees by cash or check
- Do not have Internet access
- Prefer to register in-person

Access to the online school registration system is not available to parents who have not satisfied enrollment requirements or other requirements.

- All freshmen and transfer students must provide an original birth certificate, proof of residency, a current physical
 examination form with documentation of up-to-date immunizations, and a completed dental examination form.
- All seniors must provide proof of an up-to-date meningococcal vaccination.
