2019-2020 SCHOOL REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Classes begin on Monday, August 12, 2019

All students must be ENROLLED and REGISTERED before the first day of school attendance.

Enrollment, a one-time process, requires valid proof of residency and up-to-date health records.

Registration, an annual process, requires updating of household information and payment of fees.

STEP-BY-STEP ONLINE REGISTRATION PROCESS

Between July 1 – August 4, 2019, school registration can be accomplished online using your *Infinite Campus Parent* account. Log on, select *More* on the left-hand side, and complete these four steps:

1. Review and update **Address Information**. If you have a new home address, you must contact the student services office at Schaumburg High School to update your child's residency.
2. Review and update **Family Information**.
3. For each child, review and update **Demographics**. If you have more than one child enrolled at Schaumburg High School, you will need to select each child one at a time.
4. Select the **Registration** link on the right side of the **More** screen. The system will guide you through the registration process, including payment of fees using a credit or debit card (MasterCard, Visa, American Express, or Discover).

You must attend In-Person Registration if you:

- Qualify for the National School Lunch and Breakfast Program
- Want to pay fees by cash or check
- Do not have Internet access
- Prefer to register in-person

What if I qualify for the National School Lunch and Breakfast Program?

Qualifications and other details regarding the National School Lunch and Breakfast Program will be sent to all families in late July. Families eligible for this Federal program are **not** able to register online and **must come to Schaumburg High School during in-person registration** on one of the designated dates in order to complete the registration process.



Parents will receive notice of their child's school bus route and pick-up time via mail in late July.

Call the Transportation Department at 847-755-6798 if you live less than 1.5 miles from school and want to purchase optional bus transportation services.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Access to the online school registration system is not available to parents who have not satisfied enrollment requirements or other requirements.

- All freshmen and transfer students must provide an original birth certificate, proof of residency, a current physical examination form with documentation of up-to-date immunizations, and a completed dental examination form.
- All seniors must provide proof of an up-to-date meningococcal vaccination.

Students' tentative daily class schedules will be available in early August via Infinite Campus. Official class schedules will be available on the first day of school.

Schaumburg V.I.P.s (Very Interested Parents)

V.I.P.s., the Schaumburg High School parent booster club, supports the curricular and extra-curricular activities bringing home and school into a closer relationship. All parents are encouraged to join the V.I.P.s. and membership fees can be paid as part of the school registration process.

Basic Membership **\$25**
Must purchase a Basic Membership in order to purchase any individual passes.

Deluxe Membership **\$60**
Includes Basic Membership PLUS two adult athletic passes and two child athletic passes.*

Adult Athletic Pass **\$20**
Pass valid for one adult admission to all HOME football and boys/girls basketball games (excludes IHSA playoff games). *Basic or Deluxe membership required to add this option.*

Child Athletic Pass* **\$10**
Pass valid for one child (below high school age) admission to all HOME football and boys/girls basketball games (excludes IHSA playoff games). *Basic or Deluxe membership required to add this option.*

Grandparent Athletic Pass **\$10**
Pass valid for one grandparent admission to all HOME football and boys/girls basketball games (excludes IHSA playoff games). *Basic or Deluxe membership required to add this option.*

Senior Yard Signs **\$15**

*All District 211 students are admitted free to athletic events with a valid student ID.
