POSTSECONDARY PLANNING CHECKLIST

1. Attend College Rep visits this fall

• Search on MaiaLearning under the Events tab & RSVP using the Actions button

2. Research majors and/or careers

- Use MaiaLearning → Universities → Add schools to your considering list
 - o Take an interest inventory survey if you are unsure what you want to do!

3. Narrow a list of universities, colleges, trade schools, military programs, etc.

- Use MaiaLearning → Universities → Add schools to your applying list
 - Look into the cost of tuition for each option
- For trade schools and military programs, look at each specific school/branch

4. Research information about admissions requirements, deadlines, etc.

- Use MaiaLearning or Collegedata.com
- Determine if the schools you are interested in are test optional or not!

5. Create an activities summary

• Detail all of your involvement, volunteer, and work experience

6. Letters of Recommendation: Verify that the school requires a letter of recommendation. If the school does not require it, <u>do not</u> send one.

- Provide your recommender advance notice and allow them 2-3 weeks to write your letter
- Fill out and upload the Brag Sheet on MaiaLearning under Recommendations

7. Write your personal statement and/or essays (if needed by the school)

• Give yourself 3-4 weeks to complete an essay and have someone check it

8. Check the Scholarship List

Search on MaiaLearning under the Financial Plan tab

9. Make an appointment with your counselor to discuss postsecondary plans in fall

• I will be out of the building on Monday & Friday if you need to meet with me

10. Complete the FAFSA after it opens in December
