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## Title I in D211

- Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act provides financial assistance to state and local educational agencies to meet the needs of at-risk children.
- Title I funds are federal monies that are received by our state. The State Educational Agencies forward these monies to school districts who qualify.
- Hoffman Estates & Palatine High School qualifies as a school-wide Title I program, meaning that all students at these schools can benefit from these services.
