

Dear Parent/Guardian:

In April, Conant High School administered standardized exams from the SAT Suite of Assessments to its freshmen, sophomore, and junior students. Scores from these assessments are now available and students may access their scores directly through the College Board Reporting Portal using their personal College Board student accounts. Parents and students also can view the exam scores in the assessment tab within the Infinite Campus portal. The specific grade-level exams are:

1. PSAT 8/9 (freshman year testing)
2. PSAT 10 (sophomore year testing)
3. SAT (junior year testing)

Students who do not have a College Board account can create one here: <http://bit.ly/2fb47bL> Students who cannot locate their scores on their College Board account should call the College Board's Student SAT Help Line directly at 1-866-756-7346.

Additionally, students may benefit from two exam-related apps that can be installed on their school-issued iPads. The first app is *Daily Practice for the New SAT* from the College Board. This app provides a new question each day to help students build academic skills. It also can be used to scan and score SAT practice tests, and provides an easy way for students to track their progress over time. The second app is *Khan Academy*. After establishing a Khan Academy account, students can link their College Board account with the Khan Academy. Khan Academy will then develop a personalized SAT practice plan based on the student's unique exam results. Students can locate both apps, *Daily Practice for the New SAT* and *Khan Academy*, in the self-service portal on their school-assigned iPad.
