Dear Parents of Graduates:

District 211 is providing your senior the opportunity to purchase their currently possessed school-assigned 64GB iPad Air 2 at a purchase price of \$100.00. The purchase price includes the iPad, cable, charging block, and case. Lost/damaged cases or accessories will not be replaced.

iPad purchases must be made by May 3, 2019, and payments can be directed to the school's cashier. No purchases will be allowed after May 3, 2019. All outstanding school obligations must be met before the iPad purchase can be made.

Subsequent to the purchase of the iPad, all District-bought apps and licenses will be staged for return to District ownership. These apps and licenses will be removed from the iPad on May 24, 2019 or after the completion of the student's last final exam, whichever occurs first. Information regarding how to back up the iPad will be provided. Upon the student's graduation, District 211 relinquishes all responsibility for the purchased iPad and its accessories. Additionally, D211 iPad Protection Plan coverage and technological support for the device ends upon the student's graduation.


All graduates who do not purchase their iPad will be required to turn in the device and all accessories no later than May 24, 2019, for inspection of the iPad's physical status, cable, charging block, and case. All iPad's covered under the District 211's optional iPad Protection Plan, will be limited to policy deductibles as they relate to repair/replacement costs. iPads not covered under the District 211 iPad Protection Plan will be assessed charges as described below:
