Dear Class of 2020 Parents/Guardians and Students:

As we approach the final week of school, we are looking forward to celebrating the Class of 2020. Below is information outlining final Senior events.

**Monday, May 18 and Tuesday, May 19 (a.m.)
Senior Only – School Items Return / Locker Clean Out / iPad Drop-Off**

Please sign-up for a 15-minute time slot if you need to return any school-issued items, including textbooks, uniforms, equipment, iPads, etc. and/or you have **PERSONAL** items remaining in your locker, or you did not pick-up your cap and gown. All students who need to return items or retrieve personal items from lockers [must register for a time slot through this link](#).

You must wear a face mask or covering according to State of Illinois guidelines when you arrive at school. Please place any school-issued items in a sealed bag before you arrive. Enter the parking lot through the West Entrance (near student parking), and you will be directed to the drop-off station in the parking lot. You will remain in your car during this process. If you do not need to access the school to retrieve **personal** items, you will be directed to exit the lot.

For those students who have **PERSONAL** items remaining in their lockers, those students will be directed to park their car and enter the building during their assigned times. Only students will be allowed to access the building. All health and safety standards will be followed, including social distancing practices and face masks worn by students and staff members. Please note, if there are only school-issued items that remain in your locker, SHS staff members will remove those items, and you do not need to park and enter the building to clean out your locker.

Cap and gown pick-up will be available on these days for those students who did not receive them last week.

- No spectators are allowed.

- ***YOU MUST REMAIN IN YOUR CAR AT ALL TIMES.***

There may be no person-to-person contact during the ceremony. Individuals may not hand students/staff any items.

- Social Distancing Guidelines will be enforced by the Schaumburg Police Department.

- No stopping – Please be respectful and keep the line moving.

- No restroom facilities will be available.

- All students were provided with a “Parade Number” during cap and gown pick-up. The yellow paper was included in your cap and gown bag. Please tape the yellow sheet with your number facing outward in the front windshield of your car so it can clearly be seen.
